**Subject : Pending issues - Resolving of - Request for.**  
**Ref : Our earlier letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2014.**

Kindly refer to our earlier letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> of May, 2014 on the subject cited above.

In this context, We would like to draw your kind attention to the facts that the following issues are yet to be resolved in spite of repeated persuasion.

**1. Attendance of the Inspectors:**

Kindly refer to the discussion had with you in this respect. Your kind consent in this regard is respectfully acknowledged and we would like to inform you that we don't have any difference of opinion regarding timely attendance in respect of all the officials in this Department. Therefore, we once again request you to kindly direct your good offices to take appropriate measures so that no Inspector of this Region is required to put his signature in the Attendance Register on and from 1st July, 2014,

**2. Stepping Up of Pay of the Promotees at par with the Direct Recruits in the Grade of Inspectors:**

Order issued in respect of the TAs . But no such order in respect of Inspectors has been issued so far. Kindly take appropriate measures in this respect at an early date.

**3. Proper functioning of the Building Committee including Mofussil Stations.**

We are sorry to say that no direction in this regard has been issued from your good Office. You are requested to kindly take appropriate action so that the functioning of all Building Committees may take place smoothly and properly.

**4. No provision for Proper Infrastructural facilities**

a) The preliminary work of Range wise Air Conditioning under 1% incentive scheme yet to be started.

b) The order of installation of AC at the top floor of the buildings of Aayakar Bhawan Dakshin and Middleton Row have been made near about one year ago but we regret to inform you that no further progress in this respect has yet been made.

c) As far as the installation of AC machine at the top floor to the building of 3 Govt. Place West- despite our repeated requests to the Building-in-Charge for more than 2 years at a stretch – no fruitful action has yet been taken by him. The staff members feel it very much difficult to perform day-to-day work in such a tremendous hot & sultry weather. Therefore, it is earnestly requested to take necessary steps to provide comfortable ambience in the offices.

d) This is for your kind information that although AC machines have been installed at Aayakar Bhawan Uttar Building, but the same is not functioning in the right way for want of proper maintenance.

**5. Construction of Office building at Mofussil stations.**

No progress is made in this area of work. Your kind intervention is highly solicited.

**6. ZAO related problems**

This issue does not find any solution. A tripartite dialogue may kindly be arranged with ZAO authority at an early date.

**7. Compassionate Appointment**

We are very much grateful to you as the panel of compassionate appointee for the recruitment year 2012-13 has been released. We shall be much more obliged if your kind initiation will release the panel of compassionate appointee for the recruitment year 2013-14 at an early date.

**8. Transfer & Posting of Gr.C cadres for 2014**

Necessary steps in this respect may kindly be initiated as it has become overdue.


**9. Filling up the vacancy in the departmental canteen**
