Subject: Protest against recommendations of Subcommittee No-1 constituted for redistributing-CRC'2013 suggesting abolition of CIT Burduwan-matter regarding.

Kindly refer to the above

You may kindly recall that we are already in the midst of an agitation in protest against the discrimination meted out to West Bengal Region with respect to distribution and allocation of new posts arising out of CRC'2013 as per recommendations of Subcommittee No-1 headed by Sri Mirani, CCIT(Delhi).

Further, on perusal of the report of the said committee as recorded in page 147, it is noted that the committee has suggested abolition of the CIT-Burdwan Charge citing that the CAP-II report of the said charge as on 31.03.2013 showed existing number of assesseees at 51,000. We are surprised to note from where did this committee got this figure because the consolidated report of the West Bengal charge (copy enclosed) indicates the CAP-II figure w.r.t CIT-Burdwan charge as on 31.03.2013 is actually 94,933. This figure does not include the assesseees of the said charge who have e-filed their return. We are of the opinion that if this figure of e-filed returns is included, the number of existing assessee will far exceed the figure quoted by the sub-committee-1 and as such, does not warrant the abolition of CIT-Burdwan.

We, therefore, request you to use your good office to impress upon the CBDT not to accept this recommendation which is clearly based on erroneous figure and restore the CIT-Burdwan charge.
